As a part of this collaboration, a joint research project has completed by Civil Engineering B.Tech students of DYPSN under the guidance of Dr. Dilipkumar Gupta. Low cost solar vegetable dryer has been developed and it is under process of design patent.

Memorandum of Understanding

The MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) is between Government College of Engineering, Karad (Hereafter called **GCEK**) as **Mentor Institute** and **Dr. D. Y. Patil Pratishthan's College of Engineering, Salokhenagar, Kolhapur** Hereafter called **DYPCOESN** as **Mentee Institute** for the purpose of enriching the technical education process and to jointly work for enhancing the quality of education imparted to faculty, staff and students is signed on

This MOU entered between GCEK and DYPCOESN represented in this MOU by the respective Directors/ Principals on behalf of Board of Governors, of their Institutes which shall mean and include their successors in interest and assigns.

Following points are agreed upon as part of this understanding:

Terms & Conditions

1. Nature of Relationship:

- 1.1 This MOU is for collaboration between both parties, for mutual benefit, for the many purposes set out as given below to enhance the quality of the educational experience for faculty, staff and students.
- 1.2 This MOU shall be valid for 3 years from the date of signing and each party shall be at full liberty to terminate the collaboration, with a notice period of 3 months.
- 1.3 Both parties shall take all reasonable steps to ensure the successful completion of the collaboration and co-operate with each other in duly carrying out the obligation agreed upon.

2. Objectives of collaboration:

- 2.1 To organize at least Six Faculty Development Programs under AICTE -Margdarshan Scheme for faculty of mentee institutes over a period of three years by Government College of Engineering, Karad.
- 2.2 To organize at least 25 Guest Lectures by Government College of Engineering, Karad for faculty of mentee institutes under AICTE -Margdarshan Scheme over a period of three years.
- 2.3 To undertake collaborative R&D work/R&D Projects:
 - Self-Generated:** Using Infrastructure / Laboratory facilities, faculty from respective fields to jointly undertake research Programme either at Mentee Institute or at Mentor Institute. For Technology / Patents so evolved joint rights of ownership will be mooted.
 - Industry-Sponsored:** R&D/ Consultancy from industry to be jointly undertaken by faculty from Mentee Institute and Mentor Institute.
- 2.4 To do joint publications arising out of collaborative work.
- 2.5 To help and support in achieving NBA accreditation to the programs in mentee institutes and help them in carrying the SWOT analysis.
- 2.6 To guide and support faculty of mentee institutes to complete their Ph. D. in respective fields.
- 2.7 To support autonomous institutes to establish autonomy in their institutes
- 2.8 To help students of mentee institutes to increase their placement and to encourage them for higher education



3. Mutual Obligation:

- 3.1 This collaboration shall not be exclusive to both parties and shall not disallow each party from having similar collaboration with others. Except as expressly stated in this MOU, there shall be no obligation on any party to compensate the other in any manner or to make any claim.
- 3.2 Each party shall meet the expenses between them as mutually agreed.
- 3.3 Each party shall respect the other's intellectual property (IP) and shall not use any trade name, trademark, symbol/logo, or designation belonging to the other, without prior written approval. No party shall hold out as an agent or representative of the other or create any liability for the other. The parties shall indemnify the other for breach of this clause.
- 3.4 Both parties shall maintain confidentiality about any information, course material, plans, discussions, strategies or any material, which shall be deemed to be confidential and marked accordingly. Any information, course material or the like in the public domain shall not be part of this commitment.

4 Limitation and Warranties

- 4.1 Each party shall ensure that the other is not put to any liability for any act of the respective party.
- 4.2 Each party represents that they have the full power and authority to enter into this MOU in general.

5 General

- 5.1 Both parties will designate a representative from its side who will be the primary point of contact on behalf of that party.

6. Commitments from Mentee Institute towards this MoU

- 6.1 Active participation of faculty in the workshops, seminars and activities arranged by GCEK under Margdarshan scheme.
- 6.2 Efforts by faculty members in activity like joint publications, research and sharing resources
- 6.3 Readiness to bear registration fees (if any), travelling, lodging & boarding expenses of participating faculty from Mentee institute for the period spent in Mentor institution.
- 6.4 Investments for expenses in case of research activity and joint publications.



AMENDMENT TO THE MOU

No amendment or modification of this MOU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to an amendment of this agreement. The modification/ changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made/ executed unless otherwise agreed to.

ARBITRATION


In the events of any dispute or difference between the parties hereto, such disputes or differences shall be resolved amicably by mutual discussion of the Directors of the two institutes. Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises the parties have signed the Memorandum of Understanding.





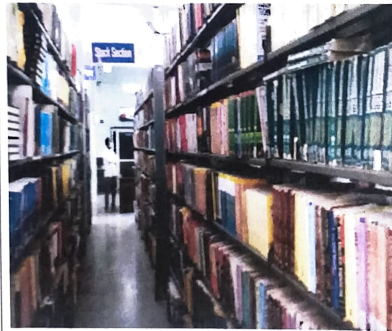

Kallimani (Principal- DYPCOESN) and Dr. A. T. Pise (Principal-GCE, Karad) in presence of Prof. Gaurav Desai, Prof. Sanjeev Deshpande, Prof. Rohit Raut and Prof. Suhas Deshmukh

About the process:

The MoU aims to provide support for research, training for faculty and students, NBA accreditation guidance, joint collaborative activities, guidance to faculty for pursuing Ph.D, organizing of workshops, FDPs, conferences etc. with GCE, Karad as Mentor Institute and DYPCOESN as mentee institute for a period of three years under AICTE Margsdarshak Scheme. Also our Team of DYPCOESN visited all the Departments and Laboratories, Library and went through their NBA documentation process.



Outcome:

This MoU will help to strengthen the relation between both the Institute and help for overall development of staff, students of DYPCOESN.



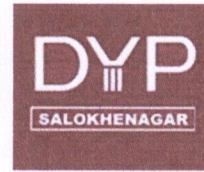

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

In order to promote co-operation between **Dr. D. Y. Patil Prathisthan's Collage of Engineering, Kolhapur** hereinafter referred to as "DYP" and the **Department of Technology, Shivaji University, Kolhapur** hereinafter referred to as "DOT", the two institutions agree as follows:

1. The two institutions will encourage direct contact and co-operation between their faculty and administrative staff, departments and research institutions.
2. Within mutually acceptable fields, the following general forms of co-operation for programmes or activities will be explored for potential negotiation:
 - Visits by and exchanges of faculty members and research scholars
 - Exchange of information including, but not limited to, research publications of faculty members
 - Joint research activities and joint supervision of research work
 - Joint conferences or symposia on subjects of mutual interest
3. It is agreed that the terms and conditions of any agreed programme and activity contemplated in this MoU shall be the subject matter of separate written agreements to be negotiated and agreed upon by both Parties and/or any third parties, wherever applicable. PROVIDED ALWAYS, the decision whether to initiate and/or implement any programme or activity shall be at each party's sole discretion.
4. This memorandum is not intended to create binding or legal obligations on either party. It merely expresses the intentions and understanding of the Parties, which will form the basis of any legally binding agreement to be drafted and executed in the future.

5. Both parties understand and agree that this memorandum creates no financial obligations on either party, and all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds with prior permission of the appropriate Authorities of both the parties.
6. Roles and responsibilities of both parties will be mutually decided based on assignment undertaken.
7. Notice and no party shall leave its commitment unfinished which may result in tangible loss to the over party.
8. The Parties agree and undertake to keep confidential at all times any confidential information or data that may be exchanged, acquired or shared in connection with any programme or activity conducted pursuant to this MoU save where the same is already in the public domain, obligated by law or otherwise defined in any subsequent agreement on the subject matter.
9. This MoU shall have an initial term of two years ending on (05/04/2025) on mutual consent with prior approval after reviewing the activities performed under this MoU. This MoU may be terminated at any time by mutual written consent or by three (3) months' notice in writing by either party, but without dishonoring any commitment entered into prior to the date of terminator and the party shall not leave its commitment unfinished which may result in tangible losses of the other party.
10. Settlement of Disputes – Any difference or dispute between the parties concerning the interpretation or implementation of any provision of this MoU shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation.
11. Every notice, request or any other communication required or permitted to be given pursuant to this MoU shall be in writing, in English and delivered personally or sent by registered or certified post via airmail or by courier or email (which shall be acknowledged by the other Party) to the Parties at the addresses stated below:







- 3.1.2 Each party represents that they have the full power and authority to enter into this MOU in general.

4 General

- 4.1.1 Both parties will designate a representative from its side who will be the primary point of contact on behalf of that party.
- 4.1.2 Both parties shall not use the name of the other in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other.



1. It is mandatory to the Affiliation Enquiry Committee to immediately submit the verified self-appraisal report, filled by the college, to the University via online / offline mode.
 2. Mention a clear opinion about the fulfillment status of the conditions, pointed out by previous visiting committee, on which basis, the said affiliation was granted in the last academic year.
 3. The Affiliation Enquiry Committee should assess all the requisite facilities, innovative practices and professional courses in the college.
 4. The Affiliation Enquiry Committee should verify all scanned photographs of requisite facilities and CDs of documents, submitted along with the self-appraisal report by the college.
 5. The Affiliation Enquiry Committee should physically check all the requisite documents / facilities and then give marks.
 6. The Affiliation Enquiry Committee should recommend the college for affiliation considering courses or other administrative factors in the college and as per the directives, based on the minimum score and percentage applicable for the college. Calculate the percentage by subtracting the marks of the points, which are not applicable.
 7. **PROFORMA A** – It is mandatory to the college to obtain minimum 65% marks in the primary requisite educational facilities to keep up the affiliation in force.
PROFORMA B – It is mandatory to the college to obtain minimum 65% marks in other requisite educational facilities to keep up the affiliation in force.
PROFORMA C – It is mandatory to the college to obtain minimum 65% marks in branch wise requisite facilities and other related factors.
- The Affiliation Enquiry Committee can recommend the college positively for affiliation, if it obtains minimum 65% marks in the Proforma A, B and C.
- If a college obtains less than 65% marks continuously for three years in the Proforma A, B and C, an affiliation cancelation proposal will be put up in front of the competent authority of the University.

8. It is mandatory to enclose list wise scanned document's CD with affiliation report.
9. As per the provision of the University Act, an action will be initiated against the committee members who submit false report.
10. CHB Teacher Workload Conversion: 01 CHB teacher for 7 hours.
11. It is mandatory to prepare separate report for each course/branch.
12. The Affiliation Enquiry Committee should mention separately the conditions of UG and PG.
13. The affiliation should not be granted for more than one year to the courses / subjects in the college even though it scores more than 71% in case of inadequate number of faculty members in the respective courses / subjects, no appointment of regular Principal or in charge Principal working for more than one year.
14. The Affiliation Enquiry Committee members should mention clear opinions about number and nature of the books and equipment excluding prices of them.
